



Countryside Management Association 2021 Photo Competition Terms and Conditions

Overview

The CMA 2021 photo competition is open for images of countryside and greenspace workers and volunteers undertaking habitat management, estate work, and wildlife survey and monitoring; leading events and school visits; engaging with visitors and volunteers and anything else which forms an interesting part of their roles.

All photos entered must include people engaged in countryside or greenspace management-related work. Photos which only feature landscapes, wildlife or non-work activities will be removed from the competition. Photos must be taken at locations in England, Wales or Northern Ireland.

This competition is open to anyone aged 18 or over (including non-members) with the exception of CMA board members, CMA contractors and the competition's judges.

When out taking photos, your safety is your own responsibility so please take care and ensure you act according to any current government guidelines regarding COVID – 19.

The competition will run from Friday 26th May 2021 – midnight on 31st December 2021.

Terms and Conditions

- 1) The competition organiser is the Countryside Management Association (CMA)
- 2) The competition is open to anyone aged 18 or over, with the exception of CMA board members, CMA contractors and the competition's judges.
- 3) The sole entry process will be via the PollUnit website:
<https://pollunit.com/polls/ucyxvv71yequladefih5eq> and as such only digital images may be submitted.
- 4) The competition will run from Friday 7th May 2021 to midnight on 31st December 2021.

5) All entrants should be aware of the nature of the competition and take responsibility for ensuring photographs are taken in a safe and appropriate way. Please ensure you are following the latest government guidance and adhering to any Covid 19-related restrictions.

6) The CMA board will nominate a panel of judges and their decision will be final. No appeals process will be in place.

7) Prizes will be awarded for first place and two runners-up. The winner will receive a £100 NHBS voucher. The runners-up will receive a £50 NHBS voucher each. Vouchers will be sent out within one week of judging (anticipated to take place during January 2022) and will be valid to be spent until 31st December 2022.

8) CMA reserve the right to terminate the competition if circumstances arise that are out of our control.

9) By entering the competition you are confirming you are aged over 18 years old and agree that the CMA may:

- Circulate the photo to media as part of press releases (if required).
- Use the photo in any presentations or online publicity for CMA trusted partners or other associated work and projects in which it or its trusted partners has a stake.
- Reproduce the photo on our website, newsletters and social media platforms

10) By entering the competition you are also confirming that any person(s) (other than yourself) appearing in your submitted photo(s) agree that the CMA may:

- Circulate the photo to media as part of press releases (if required).
- Use the photo in any presentations or online publicity for CMA trusted partners or other associated work and projects in which it or its trusted partners has a stake.
- Reproduce the photo on our website, newsletters and social media platforms

11) We will not conduct any further checks before publishing photos. You can withdraw media consent at any time by contacting admin@countrySIDmanagement.org.uk

12) The winner and runners-up agree to the use of their name and photo description submitted, in any publicity material, as well as their entry. Any personal data relating to the winner or any other entrants will be used solely in accordance with current [UK] data protection legislation and will not be disclosed to a third party without the entrant's prior consent.

13) We will notify competition winners by email shortly after judging in January 2022.
